**Senior Scholarship Award**  
Class of 2018

**Criteria:**

1. Must be a graduating senior of the Class of 2018 at Howard High School (HHS).
2. Must have achieved a minimum cumulative unweighted G.P.A. of 3.0 through the first semester of your senior year.
3. Must use the scholarship to further your education beyond the high school level at any college, university, trade, technical, or junior college.
4. Must have proven involvement in at least two school-based activities during your time at Howard High School. Involvement can be in either elected or non-elected roles or positions, in any arena of the school life (student government, athletics, clubs and organizations, honors programs, etc.).
5. Application includes an original 250-350 word essay that answers the following:

**“How I have grown personally and contributed to the growth of others during my time at HHS”**

*Discuss how you have personally grown and fostered growth in others at HHS or in the community at large. Examples could include how you were supportive of others, provided opportunities, inspired change, initiated constructive programs, and/or showed effective leadership and compassion.*

**Application Process:**

Application, essay, and any additional information should be submitted to Mr. Glenn in the Student Services Center **on or before April 18, 2018 by 3:00 P.M.** You may download an application from the PTSA website [www.howardptsa.org](http://www.howardptsa.org) or Naviance to complete, but it must be printed out and hand delivered to Mr. Glenn when finished. Individual scholarships, totaling \$2,500, will be awarded at the Senior Awards Ceremony in May 2018. A check issued by the Howard High School PTSA will be made out to the recipient’s school that they will be attending in the fall.
